Urgent Notification

SUB : <u>Follow the Govt. order no. 707-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 29.05.2021 to combat</u> spread of Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19)

In pursuance of the Govt. order issued by the Hon'ble Chief Secretary, Govt. of West Bengal, vide memo no. 707-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 29.05.2021 in view of the evolving situation on the spread of the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19), the Co-ordinators / H.M. of all study centres under The West Bengal Council of Rabindra Open Schooling are requested to follow the Govt. order issued by the Hon'ble Chief Secretary, Govt. of West Bengal, vide memo no. 707-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 29.05.2021 (attached herewith) as precaution to check the spread of Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) in West Bengal.

ORDER

No 707- ISS/2M-22/2020

Dated 29 /05/2021

Whereas in order to contain spread of COVID-19 pandemic State Government vide No 647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 15/05/2021 notified certain restriction measures in terms of the provisions under Disaster Management Act 2005 read with West Bengal Epidemic Disease, Covid-19 Regulations 2020 which are in effect from 6 AM of Sunday 16th May 2021 to 6 PM of Sunday 30th May 2021;

Whereas some clarifications and exemptions from restrictions were further notified vide No 691 -ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 23/05/2021;

Whereas after a review of the prevailing situation and expecting positive impact of the containment approach of restriction measures on declining number of new cases, State Executive Committee of West Bengal State Disaster Management Authority recommended further extension of the stipulated restrictions;

Now, after consideration of the recommendations of State Executive Committee of West Bengal State Disaster Management Authority, restriction measures as notified in aforesaid orders stands extended upto 6PM of Tuesday, 15th June 2021 with following additional clarification:

i) Operations in Jute Mills shall be allowed with 40% of the total strength of each shift.

Wearing of masks, maintenance of physical distancing and health & hygiene protocols must be followed at all times.

Management bodies / owners /supervisors of all permitted activities and work places shall be responsible for required arrangements of COVID safety measures, compliance of stated directives and COVID appropriate norms.

District administration, police commissionerates and local authorities shall ensure strict compliance of the stated directives. Any violation of the restriction measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and under Indian Penal Code.
